Winter was mild with less rain than normal. Spring began with above average temperatures in April and May, bringing bud break forward. Temperatures dropped back to normal as of mid-May and there were even several very cold nights, albeit never freezing.

It was a year with good fruit set when green harvesting was vital to achieve optimal balance. Summer started with moderate temperatures that continued until late August and rose above average in September, contributing to excellent ripening.
